Following an extensive review and consultation process, ACICA is launching its revised Arbitration Rules and Expedited Arbitration Rules which will come into effect on 1 January 2016. ACICA has revised its Rules to reflect developments in international arbitration. The new Rules build on ACICA's established practice of providing an effective, efficient and fair arbitral process. Developments of note include provisions on consolidation and joinder, appointment of experts by the tribunal and the conduct of legal representatives, along with the introduction of an expedited procedure for lower value or urgent matters commenced under the Arbitration Rules.

This seminar will introduce the new Rules and provide a comprehensive overview of developments.
